- Cultural sensitivity already possessing/having eagerness for gaining communication and language skills to understand diverse cultures and values of others in order to be able to cooperate.
- **Responsibility as part of society** having a motivated and inquisitive mind to become an advanced professional in agriculture and its related fields.
- **Society Development** having eagerness to solve matters on food, environment and organisms by utilizing advanced academic knowledge and techniques acquired in regional societies.
- 2 The following abilities and achievements will be evaluated in the entrance examination for the Graduate School of Agriculture:
- Understanding the basic academic ability and the research methods and techniques necessary for conducting research required to understand and solve the problems of agriculture in general.
- Language skills required to understand diverse cultures and the international community.
- Logical thinking and judgment required to comprehensively understand various issues covering agriculture in general.

In order to confirm the abilities and qualities written above in the entrance examination, ability for logical thinking and judgement to conduct research are evaluated in the interview, and a comprehensive judgment will be made.

2. Application requirements

 - ② Applicants who have received a bachelor's degree in accordance with National Institution for Academic Degrees and Quality Enhancement of Higher Education under the provision of Paragraph 7 of Article 104 of the School Education Act by September 2022.
 - 3 Applicants who have completed 16-year school education program overseas by September 2022.
 - 4 Applicants who have completed 16 years of formal education in foreign countries by taking a correspondence course through a non-Japanese university while residing in Japan or will complete it by September 2022.
 - (5) Applicants who have successfully completed 16 years of formal education and earned a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree from an undergraduate program at an educational institution in a country outside of Japan, which has been assessed by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) of Japan to be equivalent to an undergraduate program in the education system of Japan, or who will complete it by September 2022.
 - ⑥ Applicants who have completed a professional program (the program must have a course term of more than 4 years or fulfill other criteria stipulated by the MEXT) at a special technical school after the date stipulated by the MEXT on which that school was specially designated by the MEXT by September 2022.
 - Applicants who are expected to be granted a degree corresponding to a bachelor's degree in the relevant year by completing a program where the course term is 3 years or more in overseas universities or other overseas schools by September 2022 (Note 2).

9. Long-term study program

- The standard term of study is 2 years. The long-term study program is available for those who wish to study and complete a degree through long-term enrollment due to their time limitation. Under this long-term study program, students are able to extend their term of study up to 4 years. The annual tuition under the long-term study program is determined by dividing the total fee paid for the regular program of standard term of study (annual tuition fee x 2 years) by the number of years allowed under the long-term study program (The new tuition fee will be applied when the tuition fee is changed during their enrollment).
- Under the long-term study program, students are allowed to have the 2 years' leave that regular students are also allowed. In this leave, students will be treated as a holdover (a student enrolled in a course for a subsequent time) and tuition fee will be the same as regular students when the term of this program is over.
