 - Applicants must have completed the school education In Japan, which are conducted by a foreign educational facility (5)positioned as an facility that has curricula of a university (where the applicants have completed 16 years of the school education under said foreign country's school education system) under said foreign country's school education system and designated separately by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology
